**Citing Web sites can be tricky business! Use this worksheet to help you find all the parts and pieces of one of the sample Web sites used in Activity 4b (Internet addiction), or use a Web site about your own topic.**

Here are the basic pieces of information to collect about an Internet/Web source in order to cite its use in a research paper:

1. **Author and / or Sponsor:**
2. **Title of the individual "article" or information page:**
3. **Title of the main home page -- look for a link on the information page to "HOME" or "MAIN":**
4. **Date the page was posted/updated -- if date is not given on the page itself, try clicking on "View > Page Info" in Netscape Web browser:**
5. **Address URL (location):**
6. **Date you accessed the page -- pages can be here today, gone tomorrow:**
