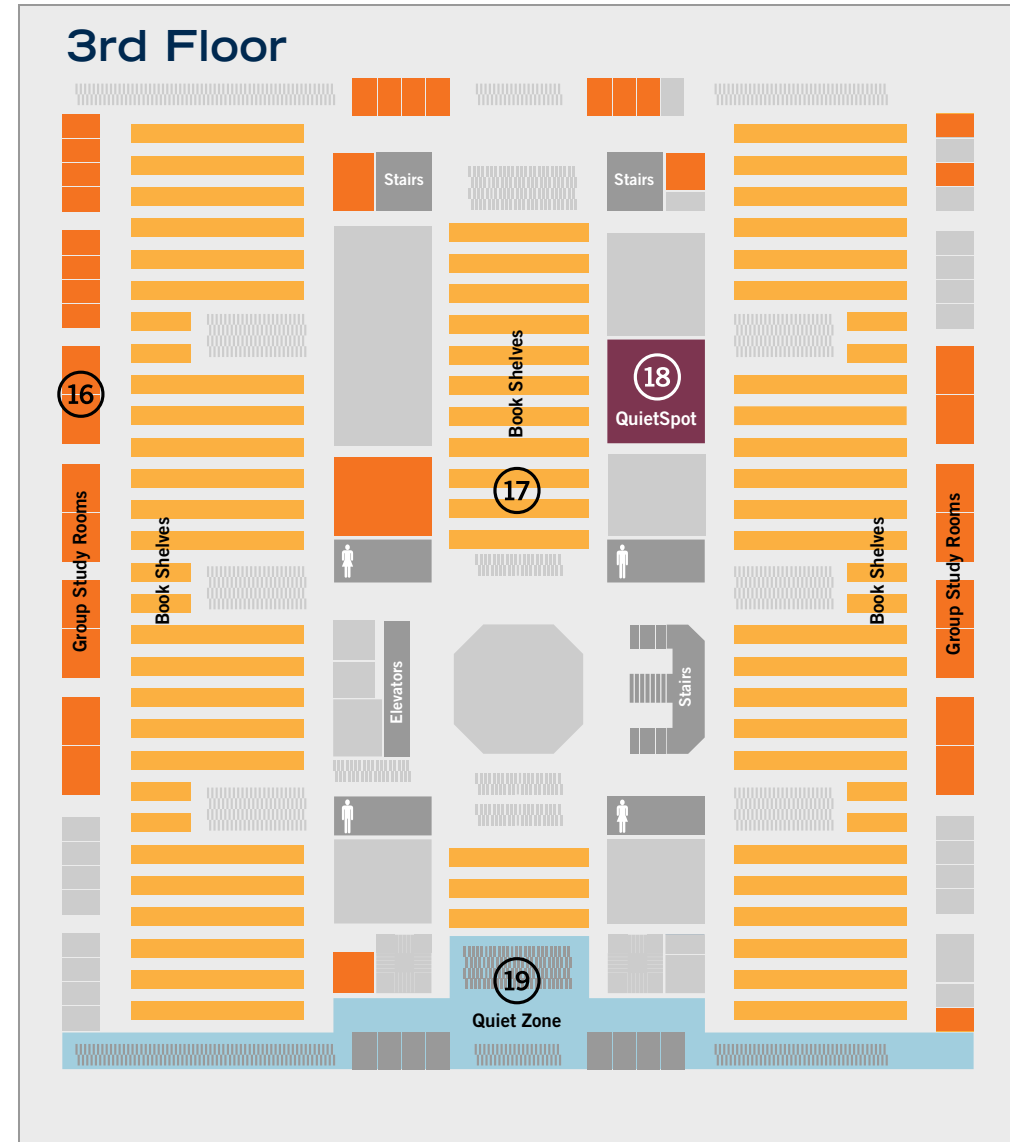


John Peace Library – Self Guided Tour



2ND FLOOR

- 1 Front Desk**
Borrow laptops, textbooks, course reserves, multimedia equipment, and books, just to name a few
- 2 Multimedia Center**
Behold our collection of CDs, DVDs and curricular materials – also home to our Engineering Corner computer workstations
- 3 Team Space**
A mini version of our GroupSpot room with four collaborative study tables
- 4 Laptop Lounge**
A landing spot between classes – take advantage of our courtesy charging stations
- 5 Information Desk**
Help with projects, assignments and paper research, or just finding your way around UTSA – ask us anything!
- 6 GroupSpot**
A state-of-the-art digital classroom and study space, perfect for group work
- 7 Quiet Study Room**

- 8 Information Commons**
A productive computing hub, just a stone's throw away from tech support and reference assistance at the Info Desk



2ND FLOOR (cont.)

- 9 Quiet Computing**
Use one of the 70+ computers in this distraction-free zone or bring your own
- 10 Group Study Rooms**
For 2–6 people, all with whiteboard walls
- 11 Quick Print**
Send documents to any PrintSpot printer in the library or anywhere on campus
- 12 Scan Spot**
Free, high speed scanners – save files to a USB or email them to yourself
- 13 Room Reservation Kiosk**
Reserve a group study room up to one week in advance – via this kiosk, your phone, or our website
- 14 Tutoring Services & QLab**
Get the help you need – a free service for all students
- 15 Writing Center**
Help with papers, cover letters, personal statements and other writing projects



3RD FLOOR

- 16 Group Study Rooms**
For 2–6 people, all with whiteboard walls
- 17 Book Shelves**
Our e-collections are growing fast, but we still have lots of books – 111,436 feet of shelving, to be exact
- 18 Quiet Spot**
Over 20 study carrels in a noiseless environment
- 19 Quiet Zone**
Designated quiet study area to be one with your thoughts

4TH FLOOR

- 20 Special Collections Reading Room**
Where we keep UTSA's treasures – rare books, manuscripts and one-of-a-kind historical documents
- 21 4th Floor Study**
Great study area, also home to our microforms and government documents
- 22 4th Floor Commons**
Computer workstations and study carrels for getting your work done
